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2026 SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM for the Dependents of I.U.O.E. Local 115 Members of the FERNIE, SPARWOOD, ELKFORD and CROWSNEST PASS SECONDARY SCHOOLS

1. ELIGIBILITY

Four scholarships, each for \$500.00 shall be awarded to students who:

- 1-1 Fulfils B.C. or Alberta graduation requirements at a secondary school in Elkford, Fernie, Sparwood or Crowsnest Pass.
- 1-2 Enrols in an education program at a post-secondary institute.
- 1-3 Have not won another scholarship of **\$1,000.00** or greater.
- 1-4 Have a grade point average of at least 2.5 based on the criteria as outlined in the scholarship application form.

2. SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

- 2-1 Dependents of Local 115 members in good standing, employed at the Line Creek Mine will compete equally between academic, technical, vocational, industrial or business courses.
- 2-2 Dependents of Local 115 members in good standing, but not employed at the Line Creek mine will compete as above.

3. APPLICATIONS

- 3-1 Students wishing to apply for a scholarship must complete the attached application and have it verified by the Principal or his representative.
- 3-2 The Principal shall be responsible for providing the letter grade and grade point average required on the application.
- 3-3 The Principal or school representative shall make a recommendation as to candidates they feel deserve the scholarship to the council of the International Union of Operating Engineers.

4. PRESENTATION OF SCHOLARSHIP

- 4-1 Awards will be presented by a representative of the International Union of Operating Engineers at a time and place mutually agreeable to the International Union of Operating Engineers and the Principal of the individual schools.

5. PROCEDURES FOR AWARD

- 5-1 The recipient of the scholarship shall receive a letter from the local council of the International Union of Operating Engineers giving the details of the scholarship.
- 5-2 The student shall be responsible for providing the International Union of Operating Engineers with verification of enrolment at the post- secondary institute.
- 5-3 Upon receipt of verification, the local council of the International Union of Operating Engineers shall issue a cheque for \$500.00 to the student.
- 5-4 The recipient of the scholarship may upon written request (by September 30, of the year of the scholarship) have the monies deferred for one year, after which the monies shall re accrue to the local council of the International Union of Operating Engineers.

6. ADMINISTRATION OF AWARDS

- 6-1 The local council of the International Union of Operating Engineers reserves the right to award the scholarship according to the recommendations of the individual schools.
- 6-2 Should there be no eligible student at a given school, the scholarship shall not be awarded during that year.
- 6-3 The scholarship shall be administered by the local council of the International Operating Engineers.
