As a potential BC Excellence Scholarship Applicant, you are asked to submit the following as part of the nomination form.

Mount Baker staff will review all applicants' written statements and then encourage the nominee (1) to complete and submit the application with our school principal's endorsement. The written statement must be handed to the counselling staff by 3:30 pm February 6, 2026. The student who is selected as the nominee must have the online application completed and submitted by 1pm on February 17, 2026.

Written statement - maximum 500 words (no bold or underlining). Statement must describe:

*In a well-developed, multi-paragraph response, describe one experience that helped you decide on your intended career or area of post-secondary study.

In addition, describe in your answer how you demonstrated one or more of the following core competencies:

- Communication (communicating and collaborating)
- Thinking (creative thinking and critical and reflective)
- Personal and Social (positive personal and cultural identity; personal awareness and responsibility; social awareness and responsibility)
