## Graduation Requirements Planning Checklist

### Grade 10: Six Required Courses

- An approved English Language Arts 10 (4.0 credits)
- Foundations of Math & Precalculus 10 **OR** Workplace Math 10 (4.0 Credits)
- Social Studies 10 (4.0 credits)
- Science 10 (4.0 credits)
- Physical Education 10 **OR** Girls PE 10 **OR** Gym-Free PE 10 (4.0 credits)
- Career Life Education 10 (4.0 credits)
- Two elective courses (4.0 credits each = 8.0 credits)

**TOTAL: 32 Credits**

### Grade 11: Four Required Courses

- An English Language Arts 11 (4.0 credits)
- A Mathematics 11 **OR** Mathematics 12 (4.0 credits)
- A Social Studies 11 **OR** Social Studies 12 (4.0 credits)
- A Science 11 or 12 (4.0 credits)
- Four elective courses which can include additional academic courses (4.0 credits each = 16.0 credits)

**TOTAL: 32 Credits**

### Grade 12: Two Required Courses

- An English Language Arts 12 (4.0 credits)
- Career Life Connections 12 (4.0 credits)
- Six elective courses which can include additional academic courses (4.0 credits each = 24.0 credits)

**TOTAL: 32 Credits****Overall Minimum 80 credits = 52 required credits & 28 elective credits**

These credits must include:

- 16 credits (4 courses) at the Grade 12 level (Includes English 12 & CLC-12)
- One Indigenous-focused course (Usually an English or Social Studies offering)
- One Arts Education or Applied Design, Skills, or Technology Course

Other requirements:

- Grade 10 Numeracy Assessment (typically scheduled with Math 10 course)
- Grade 10 Literacy Assessment (typically scheduled with English 10 course)
- Grade 12 Literacy Assessment (typically scheduled with English 12 course)

Important notes:

- Full time Mount Baker students are prioritized for elective seats
- Support blocks/spares do not count towards credits
- Internal Scholarships require full-time student status of 8 courses (1 can be Support Block)
