
Back to School Forms

All students will be heading home with a package of forms that need to be completed, signed and returned to their classroom teacher.

Some of the forms included are:

- Student Verification Form: Please review and indicate any changes or updates required. This information is very important to ensure that we have the correct contact information on file in case of an emergency.
- Low-Risk Field Trip Permission Form: This is for low-risk, local field trips around our school neighborhood.
- **Personal Information Consent Form:** This form must be completed yearly.
- **BC School Fruit & Vegetable Program:** Please complete this form if you would like your child to participate. *Only for students who have not previously participated in the program.*





Childhood Experiences Questionnaire for Kindergarten Families


Kindergarten parents are welcome to join Principal Hart in the library on Wednesday, September 10th from 9:30 - 11:00 am to fill out the CHEQ questionnaire.

CHEQ stands for Childhood Experiences Questionnaire and it gathers important information about children's experiences prior to kindergarten – collecting actionable information that schools and communities can use to support children and families and ensure a solid foundation for healthy development and well-being. Families will also have the option of filling out the CHEQ questionnaire from home after they receive their login code the first week of school.

Laura-Lee Philips, District Principal of Early Learning, will be available on Wednesday morning in the library to support filling out the survey for our Kindergarten parents and answer any questions they might have. It's also a great opportunity to meet other Kindergarten parents in the school.

Parking with Student Safety in Mind

Not unlike many other schools in Cranbrook, our school is a busy place during student drop off and pick up. Please take extra precaution and look out for pedestrians and cyclists as you park and leave the school.

Parents dropping children off in the morning or picking children up after school are asked to keep loading and bus lanes clear. The lane on the east side of the school is reserved for buses only. For safety reasons, please do not use this area as a drive through to drop off or pick up children. As well,

our accessible parking stall in the staff parking lot is reserved for families who need the access. Please do not park in this space at any point of the day.

The safest location for families to pick up or drop off their children is on the south (school) side of 13th Street, adjacent to the




school. Parents are encouraged to meet their children and walk with them to their vehicles. Students walking or riding their bikes to school are expected to use the crosswalk. If your child is a responsible older student, consider picking them up 5 – 10 minutes after the bell which will alleviate some of the traffic congestion.

Bicycle Safety

We are a community catchment school which means many kids are within walking or biking distance to school. We love to see students biking or walking to school with friends or family, getting fresh air and exercise to help their brains wake up and take in the learning of the day. Parents are asked to review bicycle safety with their children; we expect all students to wear bicycle helmets. Students can park and lock their bikes in the racks provided and are asked not to ride them on the school grounds. Skateboards, roller blades, heelies, and scooters are not allowed on school property during the hours of school operation.


BC School Fruit & Vegetable Program
