STEEPLES STUFFY WALK FUNDRAISER

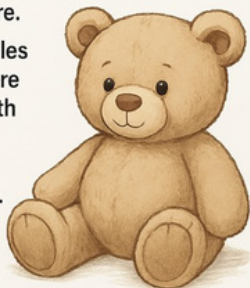
Steeple's School is in search of good, used condition stuffed animals!

Mixed Sun Basket

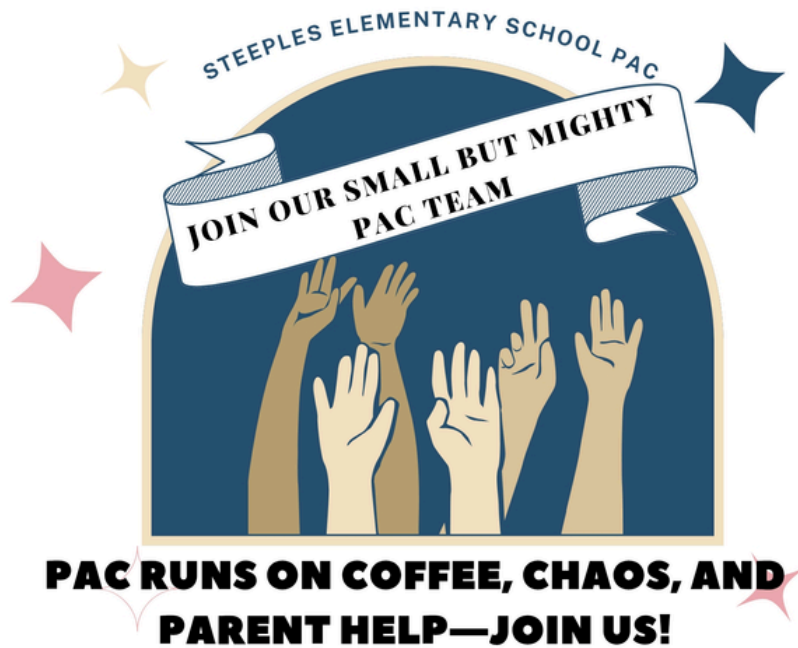

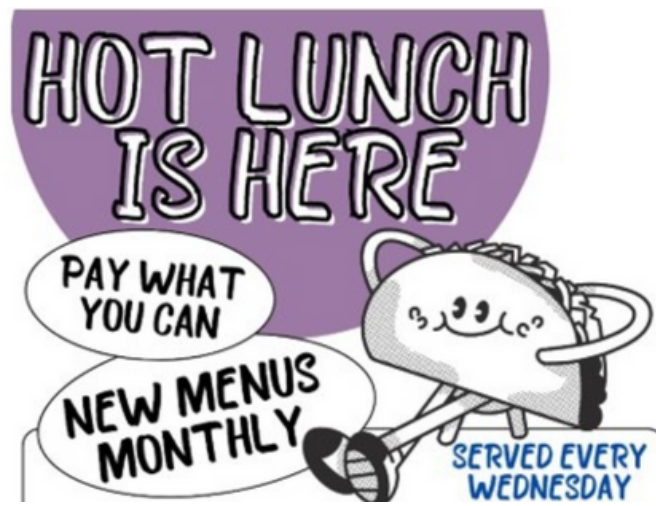
