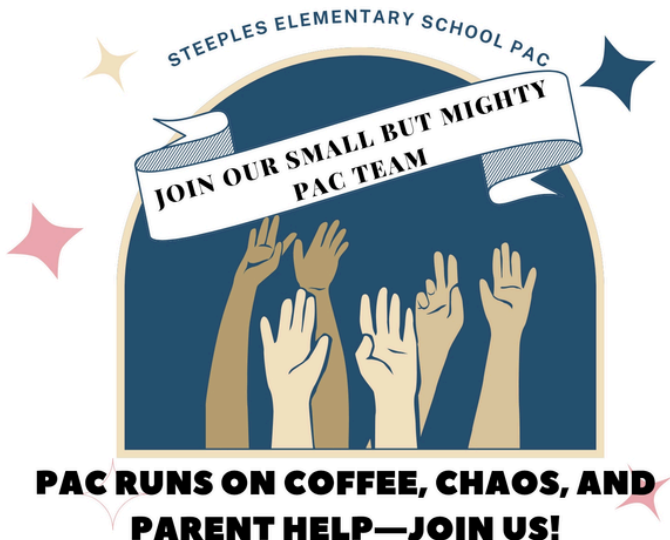

The Cranbrook Public Library would like to invite your child to join the 2026 BC Summer Reading Club! This year's theme is "*Under the Sea.*"

Registration is free and easy! Visit the library starting June 27 to register and pick up a reading log, or register online at: app.bcsrc.ca

Programs, activities, Storytimes, and contests all begin during the first week of July. Children who complete their reading logs by August 18 will be invited to attend our closing ceremonies, where they will receive a medal and enjoy pizza and cake! To help keep children engaged all summer long, we offer a variety of activities, contests, and prizes as each section of the reading log is completed.

The BC Summer Reading Club encourages school-aged children to continue reading throughout the summer to help prevent the "summer slide." Children are encouraged to read whatever interests them most — including storybooks, nonfiction, graphic novels, audiobooks, and books in any language they feel most comfortable reading.
