Dear Hon. Minister Fleming:

RE: Request for Funding for Needed Repairs to MBSS Drama & Music Rooms

School District 5 (SD5) Board of Education brought forward and carried the following motion:

M/S that the Board write a letter to the Ministry of Education to petition for the \$382,250 estimated cost for repairs to the Mount Baker Secondary School Drama and Music rooms and bring to the May 8, 2018 Board meeting.

Our Board has been advocating for the replacement of Mount Baker Secondary School (MBSS) since 2008. MBSS, located in Cranbrook, is almost 70 years old and is the largest school in the East *and* West Kootenay.

The Key City Theatre (KCT) is attached to MBSS and shares structural framework, plumbing and HVAC (and deficiencies) with the school and provides considerable opportunity to our students. Studies and audits of the past 20 years identify major deficiencies in structure, fabric, operation, function, code, compliance and accessibility as identified in the most recent, detailed and comprehensive report of required structural, mechanical and electrical upgrades. WSP Architects completed the most recent and comprehensive study in 2017, with cost estimates updated on April 17, 2018.

The dangerous lack of structural integrity to the joint School and Theatre roof has made "temporary" repairs by the District over the past decade a necessity. Recently, increasingly inclement winters and the subsequent increased snowfall experienced in our region has caused additional stress to the roof, further

compromising the roof's structural integrity. Consequently, additional supervision and upkeep by our maintenance staff to ensure the safety of our students has become yet another cost increase to our District.

Recently, the Key City Theatre Society (KCTS) Board was awarded a grant for \$487,015 from the Columbia Basin Trust (CBT) to assist in the approximately \$800,000 upgrade required to provide lasting access to a safe, fully functional, live performance space. The City of Cranbrook has contributed \$150,000, SD5 has invested \$150,000 and Area C of the Regional District of East Kootenay (RDEK) has contributed \$10,000 toward this project.

Despite the fact that KCT and the MBSS music and drama rooms share structural framework, including roof trusses etc., the Columbia Basin Trust grant can *only* be used to address the KCT structural deficiencies, given that the school is ultimately the responsibility of the Ministry of Education.

There is an opportunity for significant cost and timesaving for the District if the structural deficiencies of the MBSS music and drama rooms are completed in concurrence with the KCT repairs. However, after sixteen (16) years of underfunding of the education system in BC, the District is hard-pressed to find the monies required for these additional upgrades —especially in light of the costs associated with Fernie's Isabella Dicken Elementary School (IDES)'s everincreasing enrolment needs and the six portables the District has had to furbish and resource to accommodate the huge student increase.

It is for these reasons that the SD5 Board is requesting that the **Ministry of Education provide our District with a Capital Grant of \$382,250** –the estimated cost (enclosed) required in order to extend the KCT structural repairs to the MBSS Drama and Music rooms.

Over the past decade, our Board has worked hard to advocate for the replacement of MBSS without result.

Our region contributes significantly to BC's economy. According to Urban Futures, Regions & Resources: The Foundations of British Columbia's Economic Base report, based on information from the last Long Form Census, it was noted that "The Kootenays more than pulled its per capita weight in terms of export earnings with a total of \$33,712 export value generated per person". This is more than double the provincial average.

While we are still advocating for a *full school replacement*, we hope you will see the practicality of funding repairs of the faulty trusses in the MBSS music and drama room while the Key City Theater is upgrading its own structural integrity.
