

LOCALLY DEVELOPED AND BOARD/AUTHORITY AUTHORIZED COURSES AND TEXTBOOKS

Background

The District encourages the institution of locally developed courses to meet the needs of the students and community. Locally developed curriculum must be consistent with the Provincial Goals of Education and the Mission Statement. Approval shall be by resolution of the Board and filed with the Ministry of Education as per Ministry guidelines.

Procedures

1. All proposed locally developed courses/textbooks must be submitted to the Superintendent for approval prior to presentation to the Education/Policy Committee:
2. Proposals shall meet the requirements as detailed in the [Board/Authority Authorized Courses Requirements and Procedures Guidebook](#), including:
 - 2.1. Rationale for the proposal
 - 2.2. BAA Course Form
 - 2.3. BAA Framework Template
3. Detailed submissions must be made by March 31 of the current school year.
