This guide provides instructions for logging in to <u>MyEducation BC</u> for the first time, completing the security verification steps, and changing passwords.

# **LOGGING IN**

Visit the school district website. Click the MyEducation BC link under the featured links at the bottom of the page.



The following login fields will appear.

Login ID: type in the login name provided to you ("sd5-firstinitiallastname")

Password: type in the password provided to you.

Click the **Log On** button. If this is the very first log-in with this username and password, you will be prompted to immediately change the password and to provide additional information.

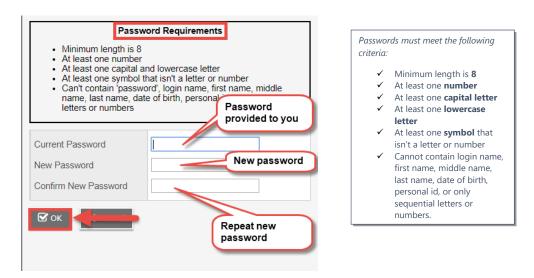




# In the new pop-up window:

Current Password: enter the password used on the first log-in screen.

**New Password**: enter the new password, observing the password rules in the *Password Requirements* information.



**Confirm New Password**: enter the new password again.

Click OK.



A *Security Preferences Update* window will appear, asking for additional information to be used if a password is forgotten.

**Primary email**: enter your primary email address that was used to create the account.

Security question: use the drop-down menu to select a question you will remember the answer to.

**Confirm answer**: enter the same answer to the security question selected.

Click **Submit**.

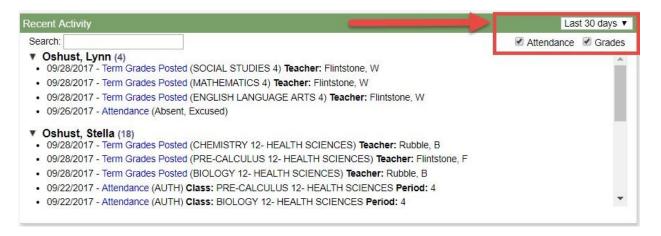
# VIEWING INFORMATION

# 1.0 PAGES TOP TAB

The Pages top tab is a one-stop information centre for parents. The symbols beside the student name at the top are QUICK links to valuable student information.

#### I. RECENT ACTIVITY

Displays attendance and marks for students within range selected in the drop-down filter to the right. Attendance box can be unchecked to view only grades activity and the grades box can be unchecked to display only attendance activity.



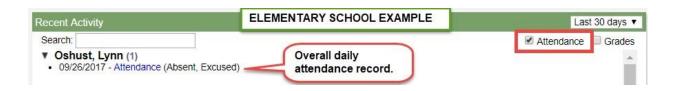
For high school students, attendance records will display with both a daily overall value, as



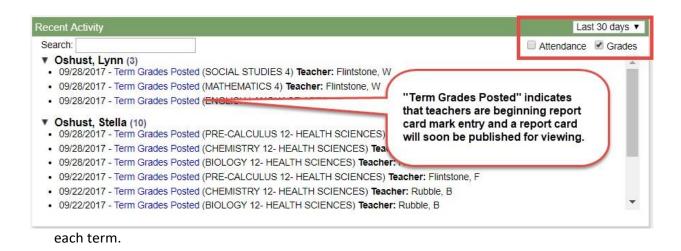
well as a record for each class for which a student was absent or late.

When report cards have been completed and published to the portal, it will appear in this area. Parents and guardians can click on the most recently published report card document to open and view the report card for their student.



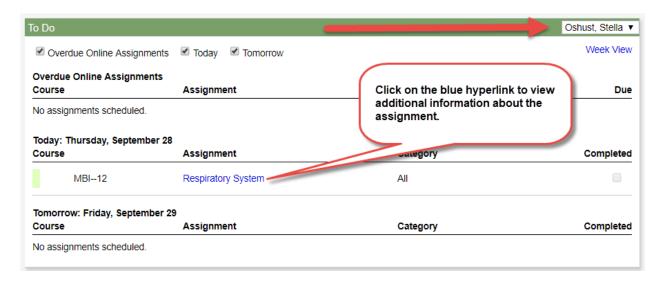

#### III. TO DO

This area will only be populated if teachers are using the gradebook functions of MyEducation BC to record and communicate student progress. Please be aware that some of your student's teachers may be using these functions and some are not.

It is normal to see information for only some of your student's teachers, but not all. Term grades posted by all teachers will appear on the report card whether teachers are using this area of MyEducation BC or not.

If teachers are using MyEducation BC to record and communicate progress, the parent may see information about assignments that are overdue, or that are due today or tomorrow.



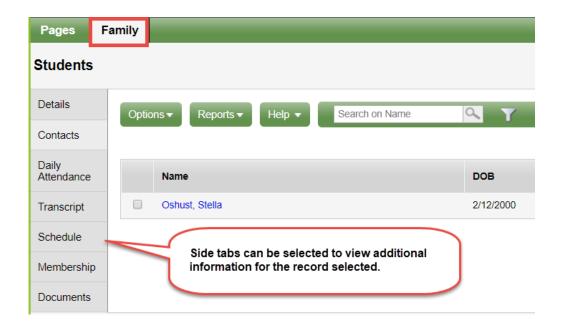
# IV. PUBLISHED REPORTS

Displays any published reports that user has access to. This is where users would see report cards.



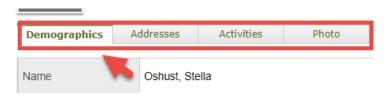
# 2.0 FAMILY TOP TAB

This area displays the list of all active students the user is connected with. Information is **read-only**. Please contact the school to advise of any changes to demographic information.



## I. DETAILS SIDE TAB

Contains basic demographic information on your student. Note that when the Details side tab is clicked on, additional sub-top tabs appear. Parents and guardians can review the information in the system to ensure it is accurate. If there are errors in the information, please contact the school.



#### II. CONTACTS SIDE TAB

Contains information on parent/guardian contacts, as well as emergency contacts and other contact information provided by the parentor guardian.



#### III. DAILY ATTENDANCE SIDE TAB

Displays overall daily value for student absences. Specific class absences are not displayed here and must be viewed in the Recent Activity block on the Pages top tab. (May not be visible at this time)

#### IV. TRANSCRIPT SIDE-TAB

Sub-side tab within this area displays information on the areas that are required for high school student to meet graduation requirements of their selected graduation program.

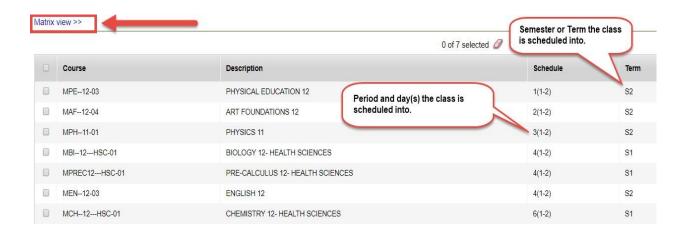
#### V. ASSESSMENT SIDE TAB

Assessment information (may not be visible at this time)

#### VI. SCHEDULE SIDE TAB

Displays the classes the selected student is scheduled into for the current year. This may be viewed as a "matrix" view or a "list" view that can be changed by clicking the small blue hyperlink in the upper left corner.

"List view" displays all courses for the school year. "Matrix view" displays current block rotation



#### VII. MEMBERSHIP SIDE TAB

Displays the enrollment history for the student, showing schools they have attended.
