BC Summer Reading Club (BC SRC): The BC SRC is a free literacy library-based program that motivates kids ages 5-14 to keep reading during the summer. Starting June 15, parents/guardians can register their kids online, help them participate in fun reading activities and connect with the local public library. Here is some interesting data from the province on student attendance. The attendance data for the province for the week of June 1-5 showed that more than 157,000 students were present for in-class instruction, which represents about one third of all B.C. K-12 students:

- Approximately 35 per cent of expected students in K-5 attended at least one day
- Approximately 28 per cent of expected students in Grades 6-8 attended at least one day
- Approximately 16 per cent of expected students in Grades 9-12 attended at least one day
- Approximately 27 per cent of Indigenous learners attended at least one day of in-class instruction
- Approximately 31 per cent of students with diverse needs attended at least one day of in-class instruction


