- Canadian citizen or Permanent Resident living in British Columbia

IMPORTANT: A completed application requires submission of 2025 Notice of Assessment of parents/guardians.

We ask that you display the enclosed poster in a prominent location to inform students of this opportunity. Applications may be submitted online from **April 1, 2026 to June 15, 2026** through the QR code provided on the enclosed poster

- Be under the age of 35
