POSITION: HOCKEY ACADEMY TEACHER

SCOPE AND PURPOSE:

The Hockey Academy Teacher instructs individual ice hockey skills and off-ice training sessions to Grade 7, 8, and 9 students enrolled in the Parkland Middle School Hockey Academy. The position involves one linear teaching block.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Specific to the Hockey Academy Teacher's position, the teacher is expected to:

1. Demonstrate and organize on-ice hockey drills and activities designed to develop individual ice hockey skills.
2. Teach off-ice sessions designed to improve fitness and skill level and to develop theoretical understanding of related topics including team systems, rules, officiating, sports psychology, leadership, health and nutrition, career paths, and current issues.
3. Supervise students in dressing rooms and elsewhere at the hockey arena immediately before and after scheduled ice times.
4. Supervise the loading and unloading equipment from the school bus.

QUALIFICATIONS:


Specific to the Hockey Academy Teacher's position, the ideal candidate will:

1. have played ice hockey at the Junior B level or higher;
2. have one season of head coaching experience at the Bantam Rep "A" level or higher;
3. have or be willing to take Development Level 1 of the National Coaching Certification Program;
4. have or be willing to acquire basic first aid certification.


ALLOWANCE:


