- 4. BC Gas Certificate with electrical endorsement
- 5. Valid Refrigeration Certification
- 6. Minimum four years' experience in gas fitting and HVAC.
- 7. Minimum one year's experience in DDC.
- 8. Minimum four years' experience in plumbing and fire sprinkler maintenance.

## MUST HAVE THE ABILITY TO:

- 1. Communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
- 2. Maintain confidentiality.
- 3. Proven ability to troubleshoot and solve problems related to the position.
- 4. Be self directed, flexible and work independently.
