- 1. Communicate effectively, orally and in writing.
- 2. Demonstrate good judgment and appropriate intervention techniques regarding student behavior.
- 3. Be self directed, flexible and work independently.
- 4. Maintain confidentiality.
- 5. Maintain a positive manner with students and the public to contribute to the "tone" of the school.
- 6. Work with disagreeable and/or hostile conditions.
- 7. Be a role model for students.
- 8. Solve problems related to the position.

RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- 1. Assist in the supervision and safety of students in and around the school during the scheduled noon hour break.
- 2. Maintain a high degree of visibility.
- 3. Maintain appropriate discipline.
- 4. Provide first alert and appropriate action for accidents and other potentially serious and/or dangerous situations, such as fights.
- 5. Report immediately all safety and discipline issues that require the attention of the supervisor or designate.
- 6. Administer first aid according to the level of qualification required.
