Social Navigation Group: Ages 9-11

This program has been developed to support kids ages 9-11 learn to navigate the complexities of peer relationships. Here at UPLIFT we build learning into play and participants will learn social concepts through conversation and hands-on activities. We build in opportunities to practice these skills in natural contexts with the support of an UPLIFTer.

This program is designed to support the growth of youth who demonstrate an ability to self regulate and are able to recognize some of the challenges they experience in social settings.

Some of the concepts covered in this program include exploring personal values, understanding others' perspective, what to do when it's just not fair, and how to decide if it's time to be flexible or stand your ground.

The social group will begin October 28, 2025 and will occur on Tuesdays from 5pm-6pm.











