Fundraising: PAC currently has a few ongoing fundraisers (as listed below) and may add others throughout the year. Proceeds from our fundraisers go towards the various PAC-sponsored events throughout the year.

- Hot Lunch – menus will be available on the Muncha Lunch site and more information on ordering will be available soon.

- Save On Foods – Tell the cashier that you would like to put your purchase toward Gordon Terrace and they will donate **5%** of your bill to PAC in gift cards. This year we have voted to have these gift cards used to buy food for students in need.



- Pizza Night – Keep an eye out for pizza night fundraisers. PAC will be working to set up fundraiser dates with local pizza places in town, who will donate a portion of each pizza sold on the specified fundraiser dates. More information to come.

Payments: PAC now accepts e-transfers. If you would like to pay for hot lunch via e-transfer, please send funds to gordonterracepac@gmail.com and be sure to reference the student(s) you are paying for so that we can apply payments to your Muncha Lunch account. If you are paying for something other than hot lunch, please reference what you are paying for (e.g., movie passes). PAC also accepts cash/cheque but we strongly encourage you to pay via e-transfer wherever possible.
